Tire Repair Kit

If a tire has a small puncture, you can use the tire repair kit to temporarily repair it. The puncture must be smaller than 3/16-inch (4 mm) and not in the tire sidewall. Go to a dealer to have the full-size tire permanently repaired or replaced.

Before Repairing the Tire

- 1. Park the vehicle on firm, level, non-slippery surface.
- 2. Make sure the vehicle is in Park (P), and apply the electric parking brake.
- 3. Turn on the hazard warning lights, and turn the vehicle off.

Getting Ready to Repair the Tire

- Pull the handle on the trunk floor lid and open the lid. Hook the handle to the edge of the trunk opening.
- 2. Take the kit out of the case.
- 3. Place the kit face up on flat ground near the punctured tire and away from traffic. Do not place the kit on its side.
- 4. Follow the instructions in the kit to repair the tire.



NOTICE

Do not use an unapproved puncture-repairing agent on a flat tire, as it can damage the tire pressure sensor.
