Briefly appear with each engine start. Red and amber indicators are most critical. Blue and green indicators are used for general information.













Malfunction Indicators

 Charging system	 SH-AWD* (Super Handling-All Wheel Drive)
 Low brake fluid, Brake system	 Malfunction indicator lamp (check engine light)
 Low oil pressure	 VSA® (Vehicle Stability Assist)
 SRS (Supplemental Restraint System)	 TPMS (blinks) (Tire Pressure Monitoring System)
 ABS (Anti-lock Brake System)	 EPS (Electronic Power Steering System)
 Keyless Access System*	 BSI* (Blind Spot Information System)

 PASSENGER AIRBAG OFF (above audio panel)	 Fog lights on
 SIDE AIRBAG OFF	 Headlights on
 VSA OFF	 Immobilizer (flashes): improperly coded key; use correct key
 CRUISE MAIN on	 Turn signals/hazards on
 CRUISE CONTROL on	 High beams on

Condition Indicators

Action is needed by driver

 Parking brake on: Release	 Message indicator: See MID
 Seat belt reminder: Fasten seat belt(s)	 Low fuel: Refill
 Door/trunk open: Close door or trunk	 Low tire pressure (stays on): Add air
