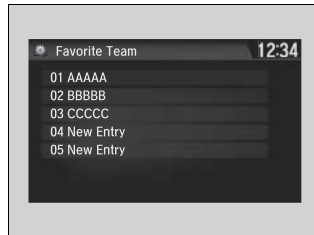

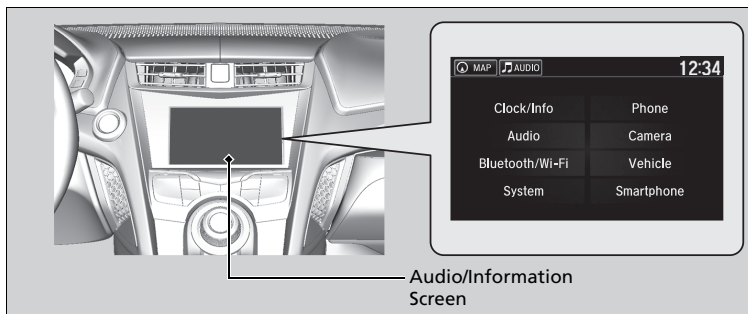

While the vehicle is at a complete stop with the power mode in ON, select , and **Settings**, then select a setting item.



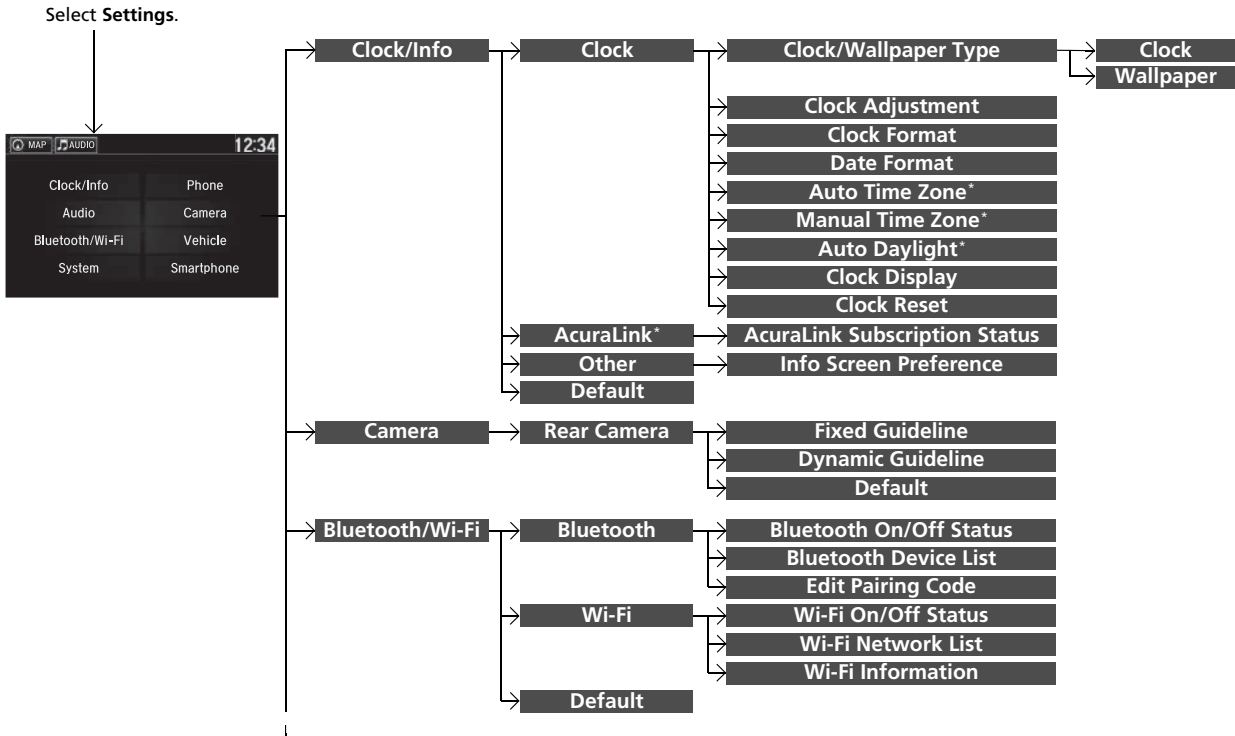
## ⌘ Customized Features

To customize other features, select **Settings**.

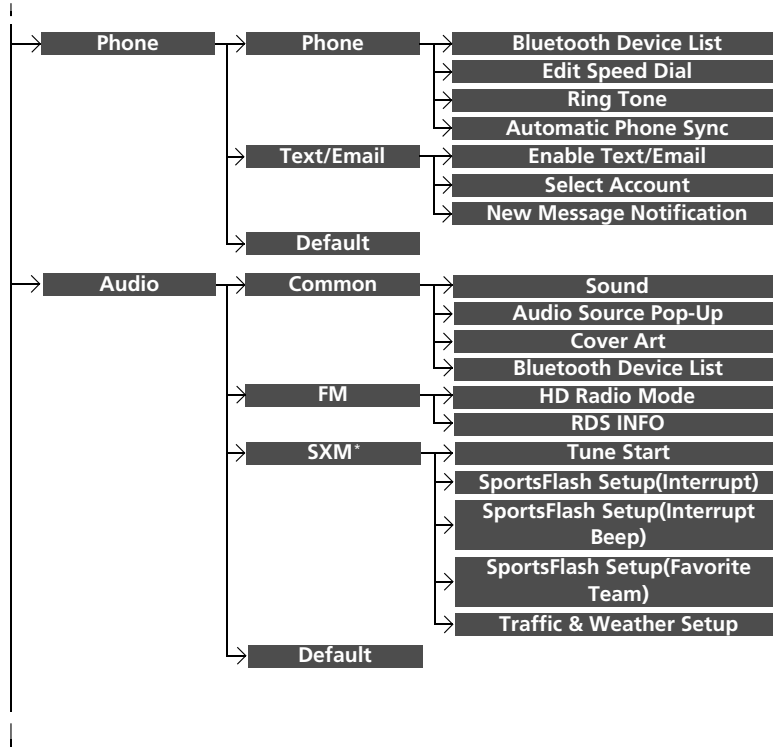

## Defaulting All the Settings

Reset all the menu and customized settings as the factory defaults.



1. Select .
2. Select **Settings**.
3. Select **System**.
4. Select the **Others** tab.
5. Select **Factory Data Reset**.
  - A confirmation message appears on the screen.
6. Select **Yes** to reset the settings.
7. Select **Yes** again to reset the settings.
  - A confirmation message appears on the screen. Select **OK**.
  - After selecting **OK**, the system will reboot.

### ☒ Defaulting All the Settings

When you transfer the vehicle to a third party, reset all settings to default and delete all personal data.

If you perform **Factory Data Reset**, it will reset the pre-installed apps to their factory default.
